To the President & the Board of Management (including delegates)

This letter is to advise your board of management that the Western Australian Men's & Mixed Netball Association Inc. (WAMMNA) and the South Australian Men's Netball Association Inc. (SAMNA) resign as members affectively immediately from All Australian Men's & Mixed Netball Association (AAMMNA).

This decision was not taken lightly and after a lengthy review both organisations conclude that the current structure is basically the VMNL doing their own thing, ignoring instructions from delegates. Furthermore the concept of Nationals is over as Non State teams are allowed to enter and in the case of Vic Allstars win the Open Mens Division, which VMNL claim is one of their teams, which is a breach of the constitution and South Australia this year entered a Club team into the competition made up of predominately Victorians, further confirming that the Easter event is no more than a Carnival, which anyone can enter and doesn't need to be run by a National body as VMNL do it well.

Why would any State body spend good money affiliating, considering our delegates are not consulted and any instruction tabled by delegates is ignored.

With regards to the Easter Carnival 2010 neither W.A. nor S.A. see any value in attending as both our associations players have other commitments next year and do not wish to over extend the finances of our players.

Depending on circumstances, changes of direction status, we will review our joint non-participation policy on a yearly basis. At the same time we are giving you notice that all information regarding both states be removed for the website with in 48 hours of receipt of this letter
